While in Alaska, Aline married Dr. Jim Coin. They enjoyed many adventures in Alaska, but ultimately relocated to California, first Santa Monica and then Palm Desert. During this time, Aline and Jim enjoyed a good lifestyle. Unfortunately, the relationship did not last and Aline moved to Las Vegas. In Las Vegas, Aline restyled her nursing career and worked in a cardiac catheterization lab. She was a tireless worker and greatly admired by her coworkers. During this time, Aline continued her love of travel. She went on

many international trips including places like Honk Kong, Africa, Europe, Australia, and the Galapagos Islands.

As a result of long hours on her feet, Aline developed back problems requiring surgery. The surgery was botched and as a result her entire life was drastically changed. Her sister, Marie Murphy, arranged for her to move back to Mississippi. For over twenty years, Aline tried to maintain her lifestyle and travels but at last became unable. Her back and mobility continued to disintegrate.

Aline was always glamorous in her fashion and attitude. She loved beautiful things and took great care to always look her best even in times of great pain. She will be remembered for her sense of adventure and for her impeccable style.

Aline was predeceased by her parents, Ivy Vowell and Sadie Manley. She is survived by her brothers, Eugene Vowell(Milly) of Prescott, AZ, Albert Vowell(Doris) of Carthage, Ms, James Vowell(Linda) of Carthage, Ms, and Marie Murphy(Bill) of Pinola, Ms. She is also survived by a host of nieces and nephews, great nieces and great nephews.
