Jack Ethridge Denson, 90, a Physics Professor, passed away Thursday, July 28, 2022 at The Carrington Nursing Center in Starkville, MS.

Mr. Denson Graduated ECCC and MSU with a Masters in Physics. He was a geologist for 6 years. In 1959 he married his wife of almost 64 years, Pequita Ellis and started his teaching career at MSU where he taught Physics for almost 40 years.

He was a charter member of Faith Baptist Church where he served as Sunday School teacher and as an usher. He was also a founding member of Starkville Academy.

Mr. Denson was a member of the Starkville Hunting Club, the Starkville Gun club, the "Breakfast Group", and the Civitan Club. He loved fishing, deer hunting,(and a little sleeping in the deer stand) and especially loved his large gardens. He was an avid MSU Athletics fan and supporter, especially MSU Baseball.

He was preceded in death by his granddog, K.J.; a brother, Lynn Denson; and 3 sisters, Katherine Garrard, Nelda Hardage, and June Shepard.

Survivors include: his wife, Pequita Denson of Starkville and son, Craig Ellis Denson of Madison.
