James Grady Middleton, age 82, of the Sunrise Community, Carthage, MS, departed this life Tuesday, December 8, 2020 at the Baptist Memorial Hospital-Attala in Kosciusko, MS. He was married on February 27, 1960 to his wife, Elois Martin Middleton. He was a member of Sunrise Baptist Church and in the past served as Sunday School Director and also Sunday School teacher.

Services of Remembrance for Mr. Middleton were conducted at Sunrise Baptist Memorial Gardens, Carthage, MS on Thursday, December 10, 2020 with Bro. David Addy and Bro. Guy Odom officiating with special remarks and reflections. Interment followed in the Sunrise Baptist Church Cemetery, Carthage, MS with Wilcox Funeral Home in charge of the arrangements.
