They were blessed to celebrate their 56th wedding anniversary earlier this month. She was a dedicated wife, mother, grandmother and servant of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. She was the epitome of the perfect pastor's wife and humbly served in this role until her death. She cherished God's word, studied it daily, and applied it her life. She was a talented hairdresser by trade, created beautiful flower arrangements, and was gifted with a beautiful singing voice. She used all of these gifts to the Glory of

God. She will be missed by a multitude of family and friends until we see her again in Heaven. She is survived by her husband, Rev. Tony Henry, her daughter, Tonya Ware (Brad), one grandson, Ben Ware; and other cherished family members and friends.
