On July 5, 1931, Malcolm G. Robinson, was born to the late Desmer and Onie Matheny Robinson of Chunky, MS. On March 28, 2024, at the age of 92 and with his family around him, Coach Robinson received the greatest award of his time spent on this earth.

Coach Mack Robinson was loved and highly respected by the numerous students and athletes he taught through his many years in the Leake County School System and especially at Edinburg High School. During his career as a coach, he received 3 Halls of Fame recognitions, East MS Community Sports Hall of Fame, MS Community College Hall of Fame, and MS High School Coaches Association Hall of Fame. He also achieved 1 State Basketball Championship.

Coach Robinson was a member of Mount Carmel Baptist Church and served in the United States Army.

Preceding him in death was his daughter, Cheryl Dawn Robinson, a daughter-in-law, Sonya Horton Robinson, and 3 brothers, Cecil Robinson, Aubrey Robinson, and Herman Robinson.
