Randolph Scott, 74, a retired minister, died Friday, March 15, 2024 at his home with his family around him.

Born in Leake County on June 27, 1949 to Jessie James and Frances Laura Comans Scott, Bro. Randolph Scott had

served the Lord in ministry for 51 years. He pastored churches in Leake, Neshoba, and Winston Counties. He

worked at Hogue & Bond for 17 years, at Wilcox Funeral Home as a funeral director for 28 years, during which

time he officiated numerous funeral services. He also served Leake County as Coroner for 30 years from 1984-2014.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a son, Mike Scott; a daughter, Shea Scott; 3 brothers, Jessie Scott, Jr,

Carl Davis Scott, and "Turtle" Scott; a sister, Linda Pickel.

On March 4, 1967, he married the love of his life, Maurice Malone Scott. They recently celebrated 57 years of marriage.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by 2 grandsons, Ian Scott and Joseph Scott.
